RE: Authorization to apply to the Department of Justice under the OVC Tribal Set Aside

WHEREAS, The La Jolla Band of Luiseno Indians of the La Jolla Reservation, California is an Indian Tribe federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior, and

WHEREAS, The La Jolla Band of Luiseno Indians recognizes the need to enhance public safety and victim services on the reservation, ensure equal access to justice for its members, and reduce and prevent crime and victimization, and

WHEREAS, The La Jolla Band of Luiseno Indians through its Tribal Council express support for an application to the U.S. Department of Justice for available funding under the Fiscal Year 2019 OVC Tribal Set Aside Program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the La Jolla Band of Luiseno Indians through Wendy Schlater, Program Director of the Tribe's -Avellaka Program apply for and negotiate with the Department under the U.S. Department of Justice fiscal Year 2019 OVC Tribal Set Aside Program. Wendy Schlater will serve as primary point of contact for grant application and funding purposes.
