Since 1998, the **Women Are Sacred Conference (WAS)** has served as a national conference dedicated to ending violence against Native women and children. Hosted by the National Indigenous Women’s Resource Center, the 2020 Women Are Sacred Conference will take place June 23-25, 2020, in Saint Paul, Minnesota.

Women Are Sacred provides training opportunities, presentations and keynote addresses by established and emerging Indigenous leaders and experts in the movement to end the violence on various topics focused on supporting tribal nations, tribal domestic violence programs and tribal community-based programs.

This is an incredible opportunity to **reach hundreds of American Indian, Alaska Native and Native Hawaiian** survivors, advocates, grassroots organizers, tribal leaders, law enforcement, child welfare, social services, and tribal court personnel.

- **1 in 2** Native women have experienced **sexual violence**. -
 - Two-thirds of sexual assaults against Native women are **committed by non-Native perpetrators**. -
- **Murder** is a leading cause of death for Native women. -
